Effective January 1: NYC retiree plan switches to **Medicare Advantage Plus**

Some of you may be servicing City of New York retirees who live or travel in Arizona. Currently, they have a group plan (Traditional Medicare with Senior Care Medicare Supplement) with the member ID

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prefix NYC. Starting January 1, 2022, their plan will become a Medicare Advantage PPO plan with the prefix N6Y. The plan is offered through the NYC Retiree Health Alliance, a partnership between Empire BlueCross BlueShield and EmblemHealth.

You may receive calls from NYC retirees asking if you are in-network for their 2022 "NYC Medicare" Advantage Plus" PPO plan. Here's how it works.

Medicare Advantage PPO network sharing applies

Most of you are familiar with the BlueCard® program, which makes it possible for members of a Blue Cross® Blue Shield® (BCBS) Plan to access their PPO healthcare benefits while traveling or living outside of their plan's service area. The program links participating healthcare providers in BCBS Plans across the U.S. and in many countries worldwide. There is a similar program for individuals with Medicare Advantage (MA) PPO plans. Because Blue Cross Blue Shield of Arizona (BCBSAZ) offers MA PPO (BlueJourney) benefit plans, we participate in the national BCBS MA PPO network-sharing program.

Claim filing and reimbursement methodology to NYC MA PPO members

Starting January 1, all claims for NYC MA PPO plan members should be submitted directly to BCBSAZ —regardless of whether you're contracted for the BlueJourney PPO network.

- If you're participating in the BCBSAZ BlueJourney PPO network, you will be reimbursed at your MA PPO contract rate for services rendered to NYC MA PPO members.
- Providers who don't participate in the BlueJourney PPO network will be reimbursed according to the Original Medicare fee schedule.

How to recognize NYC and other out-of-area MA PPO members

NYC and other out-of-area members with BCBS MA PPO plans will have a suitcase logo on their BCBS member ID card. The MA in the suitcase indicates that the member is covered under the MA PPO network-sharing program. The logo looks like this:
