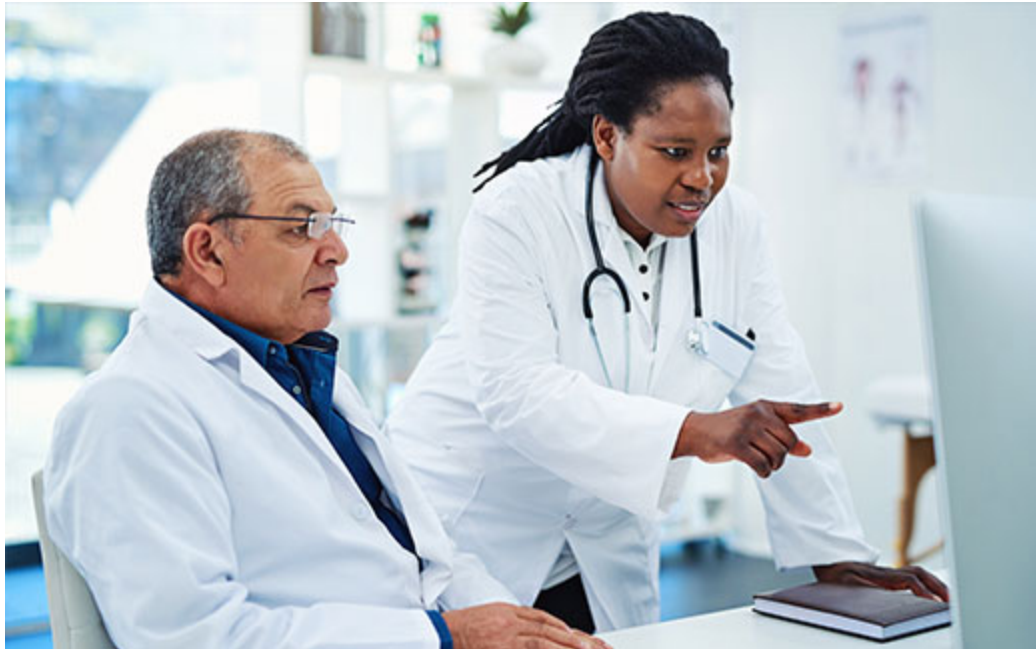

Good news: The Arizona Center for Rural Health (AzCRH) has openings in its AzMAT Mentors Program to help you increase your capacity to offer substance use disorder services.

About the AzMAT Mentors Program

AzCRH partnered with the Arizona Department of Health Services to implement the AzMAT Mentors Program. It's all about improving access to evidence-based treatment for individuals with opioid use disorders.

MAT provider mentors partner with practitioners who are Arizona-licensed and want to collaborate with a more experienced MAT provider. The mentors use a collaborative consultation model to address common barriers, such as lack of time, availability of behavioral health services, and concerns about diversion and patient misuse.

Program participants receive one-on-one consultations and access to educational materials. They set meaningful learning goals and receive ongoing guidance and support, resulting in increased confidence and capacity for offering MAT.
