This is a quick update for those of you who may be servicing City of New York 🚹 In This Issue retirees living or traveling in Arizona (member ID prefix NYC). In the October 2021 newsletter, we let you know that their group plan (currently See NIH guidance for treating Traditional Medicare with Senior Care Medicare Supplement) high-risk COVID-19 patients would be changing to a Medicare Advantage (MA) PPO plan. The implementation for that change has been delayed.

Because no member ID cards were sent out for the MA PPO plan, we don't anticipate any confusion or issues with this delay. You should continue servicing these members according to their Medicare and Medicare Supplement plans.
